Emergency Clothing Applications.

If you would like to become a partner referral agent for Emergency Clothing Library Packs, please email us on Hello@SocialFlock.org to get access to our online application form. We usually turn these packs around in 1 week, and would ask for partners to collect the pack from our Perth based hub, or forward on collection information to the individual receiving the pack.

For applications you will need to know: Clothing Size, Sensory preferences, a brief style guide and shoe size.

Please be aware sizes are updated to 'Low Stock' and 'Out of Stock' on the application forms so you know Low Stock options may take longer to complete, and for sizes under 'Out of Stock' we would suggest not applying but reaching out to us on the email above to check when this size will become available again.

Clothing Library – Self Referrals

Our applications are open to anyone who lives in Perth and Kinross and wears clothes. The link below can be sent to anyone you work alongside for them to complete their own application.

We usually have a 3-4 week turnaround for these packs, and doorstep delivery is available for all applicants.
