What does VisionPK do?

Statutory Services on behalf of Perth and Kinross HSCP

- Hold and maintain the register of people certified as Severely Sight Impaired and Sight Impaired.
- Provide specialist support for people who have sight and/or hearing loss including assessment and reviews.
- Low vision assessments
- Deliver Sensory Awareness Sessions
- Signposting and referrals to other organisations

Charitable Services (with the help of fundraising/grants and volunteers)

- Health and wellbeing activities e.g. music sessions, art groups, swimming, drumtastic, walks.
- Community Social activities and peer support groups, befriending
- Sensory Hub George Street Perth
- Volunteering Opportunities

True or False?

Most people with a visual impairment can see.

True

Only 7% of registered blind population see nothing at all.

- 100 people are formally certified as sight impaired or severely sight impaired every day in the UK
- Almost 200,000 people in Scotland are living with low or no vision
- With an ageing population and stretched National Health Service, this number is set to double in the next decade
- 250 people begin to lose their sight every day in the UK

- Only a consultant Ophthalmologist can certify someone as SI or SSI
- One in three adults in the UK are deaf, have hearing loss or tinnitus.
- 80% of people over the age of 70 will have hearing loss.
- On average, people wait approximately 10 years before doing something about their hearing loss.
